Fr. Gerry O'Connor C.Ss.R is a native of Limerick and a keen Munster Rugby supporter. He has worked for the past 13 years in Cherry Orchard Parish, Dublin. A strong advocate for justice issues, he has a passion for education and care services and heads the Redemptorist International Solidarity Office for Africa and Madagascar. He is on the leadership team of the Irish Association of Catholic Priests.
