

have about hierarchy, monarchy and what it means to be in authority. As we hear in today's Gospel, even Pilate is confused. His idea of kingship is of an all-powerful ruler, controller and dictator. Jesus makes it clear he is not that kind of king. He has not come to 'lord' it over people. He is not interested in an earthly type of kingdom. His kingdom is entirely different – it is not of this world.

Jesus isn't just talking about a different place. He is talking about a different way of living, that is not about control and power but love and service. Jesus' power comes from God and it is a power that builds people up rather than diminishes them. He doesn't deny that he is a king but it is not the word he would use. The only thing that matters to him is truth and that truth is God. Those who belong to God listen to the voice of Jesus, the servant king, and follow his example.
